Its heroine is a 16-year-old, Queens, NY Goth girl dealing with two major life-changing problems: her parents' divorce, and a frightening ability to see through the human guises of the vampires, werewolves, and other creatures that have always been living in the world. Helping Pan come to terms with both is Sebastienne Mazarin, a 400-year-old, shape-shifting monster hunter she befriends. Together, the women set out to protect the world from the monsters threatening it, starting in *Blood Feud* with a war among rival vampire clans seeking the key to an ultimate weapon.

The project might be a dark-fantasy series instead of a superhero adventure, but Roman assures fans familiar with his X-Men novels that there's something for them as well: "Just like *The Chaos Engine Trilogy*, Pan's story has action, it's got romance and humor, and it's got the thing I'm most known for: multilayered characterization. So, come for the monster hunting, stay for the widespread destruction and the oddball characters—'cause if you've read my stuff you know I never write about *normal* people. . . ." *Blood Feud: The Saga of Pandora Zwieback, Book 1*—which features cover art by acclaimed painter **Bob Larkin** (*Tomb of Dracula, Doc Savage, Savage Sword of Conan*)—is currently available from brick-and-mortar and online bookstores, and from the StarWarp Concepts Web site.
